## Hualien

Hualien's coastline is long and narrow, and faces clean ocean waters. Its geological composition is highly complex. With the rivers meeting the ocean, the surrounding ocean currents and the sea floor's rocky composition, the coast possesses habitats such as estuaries, sand beaches, gravel shores, rocky intertidal zones, rocky reefs, and coral reefs, as well as the neritic and epipelagic zones.



## Taroko National Park

The mountains of Taroko tower high above Liwu River that has cut its way through far below. The Park harbors numerous ecosystems, such as alpine tundra, Yushan cane meadows, coniferous forests, mixed forests, evergreen hardwood forests, and rivers.



## Qixingtian Beach

The most popular area of the beach is located at the Qixingtian Coast Park, located behind the [Hualien Airport](#). In this market area, local merchants sell gifts and *xiaochi* snacks, and visitors can enjoy the stunning view with an occasional plane flying overhead. The Stone Carving Park and star-watching square are in this park area.





### **Mata Saddle Wetlands**

The Fataan tribe is the largest inland wetland in Hualien and also the home of the Amis. The Aboriginal tribal is combined with special aquatic ecology wetland. In 2007, it was elected as the top ten classic rural villages.



### **Yunshanshui Wetland Ecological Park**

Ever since the famous soda commercial was made, the incredible blue Dream Lake has attracted many visitors from in and outside the country. Yunshanshui is a place very suitable for people to bring their families to visit.
